

The WRAP Judicial Coordinator

Western State College of Colorado has received a 2 year Federal grant to develop or enhance, implement, and evaluate Campus and/or Community-Based strategies to prevent high-risk drinking among college students. We are seeking to hire a WRAP Judicial Coordinator.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The Judicial Coordinator will be responsible for the implementation and enforcement of all policies and consequences for alcohol related violations on campus, and will offer suggestions for alternative activities, and other solutions such as counseling. The Judicial Coordinator will work with the Steering Committee, the Project Director, and the Associate VP for Student Affairs to develop and implement effective judicial policies and sanctions and will develop and implement trainings with students and staff who are involved in the alcohol prevention campaign and programming. —Revising the current judicial policies for liquor law violations on campus will contribute to the goal of decreasing “high-risk drinking” behaviors on campus. The Judicial Coordinator will also develop a tracking system in conjunction with the Project Evaluator to gather on-campus alcohol violation data from Campus Security, the Gunnison Police Department and Residence Life-. This collected data will be used to determine whether there is a decrease in recidivism rates and alcohol related incidents during the two year grant period. Qualitative data regarding the circumstances of each incident will be collected based on report narratives available for each case to determine which strategies are most effective.

QUALIFICATIONS: The Judicial Coordinator will hold a minimum of a Master’s degree in Counseling or an associated area of expertise to provide 1-on-1 counseling when appropriate, as well as experience working with college age students. Good communication and writing skills are also essential for this position. Hours are flexible but daily office hours are required.

Compensations/Benefits: Salary is \$15,000 annually. Benefits include an employee/employer shared contribution retirement plan, life and health insurance.
