 ESS from Western while also beginning your chiropractic coursework

Requirements for Admission to Palmer College of Chiropractic

- Completion of 90 credits at Western; including General Education courses and courses in the
 Clinical Exercise Science major which meet the prerequisite requirements for the Doctor of
 Chiropractic degree
 - o (see list of courses below; 3+1 plans are available for each Palmer campus)
- 3.0 cumulative GPA (may be considered with GPA of 2.75 with no guarantee of admission)
- Recommendation from Western RESS department Chair (or designee)
- Submission of application materials according to posted deadlines
